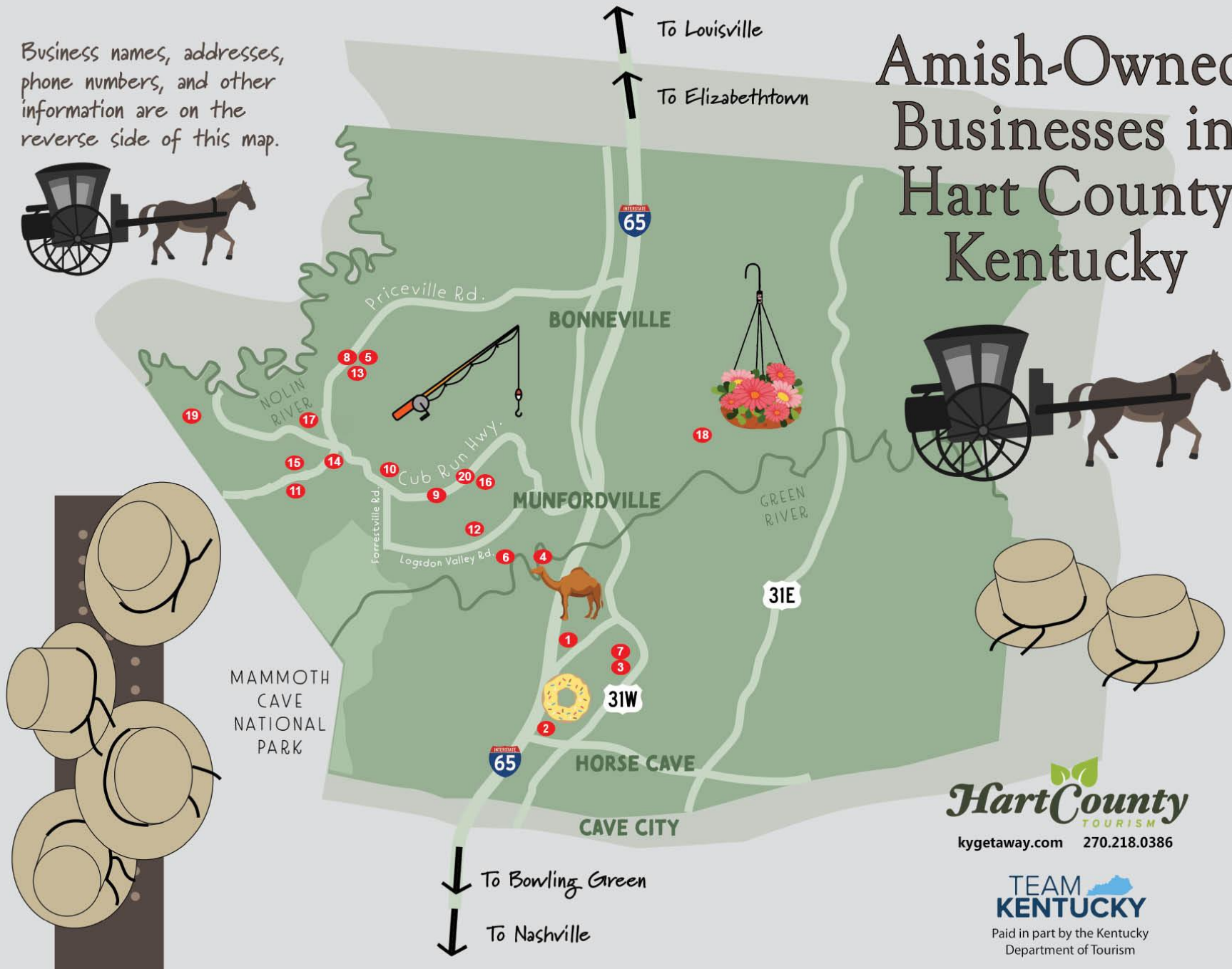

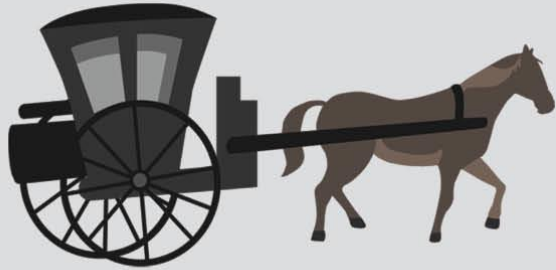


Amish-Owned Businesses in Hart County Kentucky

ENJOY YOUR VISIT TO HART COUNTY. Please Drive Slowly!

First-time visitors to Hart County, Kentucky, are usually surprised to see a horse-drawn buggy hitched to a post in downtown or slowly moving along one of the back roads. It is a scene that locals now take for granted. Members of the old Order Amish faith began moving into the area during the late 1980s, many of them from Geauga County, Ohio.

Approximately 700 families now live throughout the county, with the largest population in the Logsdon Valley/Forestville communities. Several Amish businesses are scattered throughout the county, especially in the Cub Run area in western Hart County. Their businesses include greenhouses, bakeries, window and lawn furniture manufacturing, meat processing, sawmills, salvage grocery, and general merchandise stores. Several families also grow tomatoes and other vegetables to sell to large canneries and at roadside market stands.

PLEASE NOTE: While the Amish community welcomes customers to their businesses, they ask that you not photograph the people; please honor that request. You may want to call ahead to confirm the business is open as they sometimes close for special occasions. Most businesses do take credit cards, but you may want to take along some cash as an ATM machine may not be nearby.

This map features a few of the businesses that offer goods that might interest tourists and is produced by Horse Cave/Hart County Tourism. Other Amish-owned businesses in the county that include Agriculture, Buggy Shops, Building Materials and Repair, Carpentry and Construction, Equine, Sawmills and Logging are listed in the Hart County Chamber of Commerce's 2021 Directory of Amish Owned Businesses in Hart County and are available for \$12.50. LODGING

4-Riverbend Resort, This secluded campground has 3 cabins as well as primitive campsites. Located at 1550 Riverbend Road, Horse Cave, overlooking Green River, it has fishing, boat ramp, swimming area, volleyball, cornhole, swings, kayak/boat rentals, picnic pavilion, and a cave to explore. 5 – The Farmhouse Apartment, 12827 Priceville Road, Cub Run, 270.702.0811. Private entry & porch, full kitchen, oversized bedroom, living room, dining room, and sun room. It is filled with puzzles, games, books, and walking distances to a large Amish business that consists of a grocery, deli, gift, & furniture shop. Located 20 mins from a golf course/ Double J Stables and Mammoth Cave National Park & 15 mins from Nolin Lake. Info at vrbo.com.

6 – Cedar Ridge Cabin, 2311 Logsdon Valley Road, Munfordville. This 1 bedroom, 3 bed cabin is a very primitive stay with an outhouse only and a camping shower with hot water - no full restroom. A 180-step hike to Green River with clear steps and hand railing. Propane space heater and wood stove inside the cabin. Two kayaks, coffee maker, grill, battery operated lighting, swing set, firewood, and fishing poles provided. Info & reservations at Airbnb.com for Cedar Ridge Cabin.
