

Along a pathway that leads to 5-acre Sunset Dome, the area's largest dome room that recently reopened after 70 years? We've got that!

Mild - On their hour-long Public Guided Cave Tours, you'll hear about the history of the cave and the tiny town of Horse Cave that grew on top of it. Tours go out on the hour. No reservations required.

Wild - Call 270.786.1466 ahead to reserve a space on their Off-Trail Adventure Tour, a 3-hour extreme caving adventure with climbing and crawling. Or add to your adventure when you reserve space on the Cave Entrance Rappel down the 75-foot limestone face of the cave. The only cave rappel in Kentuckyl

Amish Farm Wagon Ride or Drive-Thru Exotic Animal Safari

Hart County's newest animal adventure is located just a mile down the road from Kentucky Down Under Adventure Zoo. Explore the ¾ mile drive-thru Safari Trail where you'll see Zebra, Watusi, Camels, Emus, Water Buffalo, Yak, Longhorn, Ostrich, Zebu, Wildebeest, Donkeys, and Black Swans.

Meet Animals Encounter Area

You'll have encounters galore in this area. Get up close and personal with Sheep, Ducks, Chickens, Goats, Ponies, and Tortoises in the fenced-in area. Feed the larger animals from two platforms connected by the Humpback Overpass. Check out Camels, Pigs, and Chickens in the barn. You might even catch a glimpse of the free-roaming Ducks, Rabbits, and (if you're lucky) a baby Alpaca.

Relax and Visit a While

Take a train ride, enjoy a snack or bring your lunch and relax in the picnic area. Gifts and snacks are available to purchase in the Gift Shop, where you can meet the Hedgehog, Bearded Dragon, Hamster, Guinea Pigs, and Coati Mundi. There's even a children's playground. 


Our Gateways to Kentucky's Great Outdoors

Both Munfordville and Horse Cave are certified Kentucky Trail Towns with access to trails and places for cyclists to stop for food and provisions or to simply enjoy the scenery and charm of a local community and maybe even spend the day or the evening.

- Paddling Our Blueway on the Green paddling trails wind past springs, blue holes, and the 300 Springs Waterfall that are only accessible by boat. Go to kygetaway.com/trails for maps with mileage, points of interest, launch and take out locations.
 - Local liveries Lynn Camp Launch, Big Buffalo Crossing Canoe & Kayak, and Adventures of Mammoth Cave.
- Cycling US Bike Route 23 runs through Mammoth Cave National Park and along our rural roads and through small towns. It connects with the TransAmerica Bike Route near the Abraham Lincoln Birthplace National Historical Park.
- Hiking Mammoth Cave National Park has more than 80 miles of above-ground trails.
 The 4.5 Jenny Wilson Byrd Trail begins at Thelma Stovall Park in downtown Munfordville and goes along the banks of the Green River.
- Horseback Adventures of Mammoth Cave offers tours along the edge of Mammoth Cave National Park.
- Driving and Walking The Hart County Barn Quilt Trail is a driving trail along the countryside
 to check out more than 70 quilt designs on barns and buildings. In Horse Cave, we have a
 1/3-mile walking trail at Maple Avenue Park and the award-willing Horse Cave Stories Cell Phone
 Tour. In Munfordville, there's a 1/2 mile walking trail along the Green River at Thelma Stovall Park
 and a downtown walking tour.

Award-Winning Cell Phone Tour

More than 50 buildings are listed as a National Register of Historic Places Commercial District in this lovely historic downtown with restored iron storefronts and colorful awnings. The district is anchored by the Hidden River Cave complex that includes the cave, American Cave Museum, Historic Thomas House and Maple Avenue Park. The cave winds under the streets and sidewalks, and the history of a town that developed on top of a cave is shared through stories from locals on the Horse Cave Stories Cell Phone Tour. The cave's pathway beneath your feet is traced on the sidewalks, and you can visit the shops that line the narrow streets along the way.

Civil War History

Step back in time

Occupied for the 5-year duration of the Civil War by forces of both the Confederacy and the Union. Munfordville has several buildings that are highlighted on this historic tour. Along the way, you will learn about two famous generals who were childhood friends and then foes in battle. Begin the tour at the Hart County Historical Museum in the historic Chaptine building in downtown Munfordville.

This bit of ancient society is a (not-to-scale) replica of the English landmark created by a Munfordville resident who used native rocks. Begin your visit at the historic Anthony Woodson House at 1309 South Dixie Highway just 1 mile south of Munfordville, and continue to the battlefield at the address below.




Dennison's Roadside Market


